# Introduction

This booklet is published by the Missouri State Highway Patrol as an aid to persons who are interested in recreational boating crashes and accidental drowning incidents occurring in the state. It contains information which provides a comprehensive look at statewide crashes and accidental drowning incidents as experienced in 2019.

The Missouri State Highway Patrol is the central recreational boating data collection agency for the State of Missouri. The Patrol investigates all recreational boating crashes occurring in the state and either investigates or gathers data on accidental drowning incidents occurring in state and private waters.

## Interesting Statistics

*Here at a glance are some interesting statistics found in this booklet:*

- *In 2020 there were 14 persons killed and 108 persons injured in recreational boating crashes in the state of Missouri. This was four fewer killed and four more injured than in 2019. There was an increase of 23.03% in total crashes statewide (203) compared to 2019 (165).*
- *In 2020 there were 203 total crashes including 113 property damage only, 77 injury, and 13 fatal.*
- *"Inexperience of operator" was the leading contributing circumstance for all crashes followed by "failed to keep proper lookout." "Impairment (alcohol/drugs)" was known to have been a contributing circumstance to 13 crashes statewide.*
- *"Inexperience of the operator" crashes resulted in the deaths of two persons. This was 14.3% of the total persons killed in crashes.*
- *Of all crashes reported statewide, 70.4% (143) occurred during the months of May through August.*
- *Most crashes occurred on Saturday (84) and Sunday (37) and most (149) occurred between noon and 8:00 p.m.*
- *Of all crashes reported statewide, 63.5% (129) involved only one watercraft. Eleven of the thirteen fatal crashes involved only one watercraft.*
- *Of the 244 boat operators involved in crashes, 141 had no prior boater education.*
- *In 2020, there were 37 persons killed in accidental drowning incidents occurring in state waters, five fewer than in 2019. The Missouri State Highway Patrol also investigated 11 accidental drowning incidents that occurred on private property and an additional three that were flood/other related.*
- *Most drowning incidents occurred on Saturday (12) and Sunday (11) and most occurred during the months of July (12) and August (11).*

*It is hoped that the information in this booklet will be of value to you. Certainly it is the most comprehensive look available at statewide crashes and accidental drowning incidents in Missouri.*



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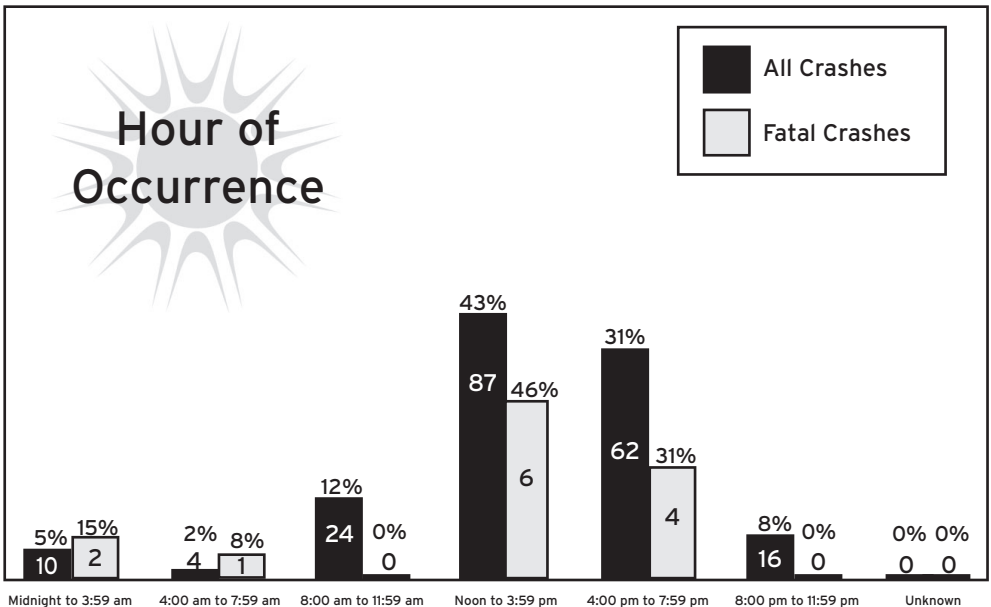
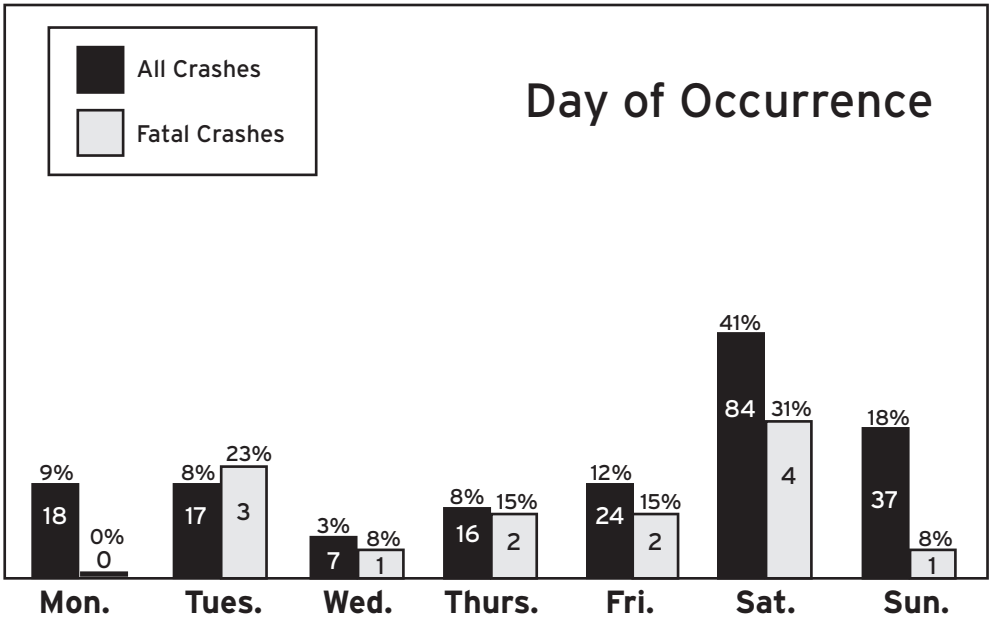

# Crashes by Day and Hour



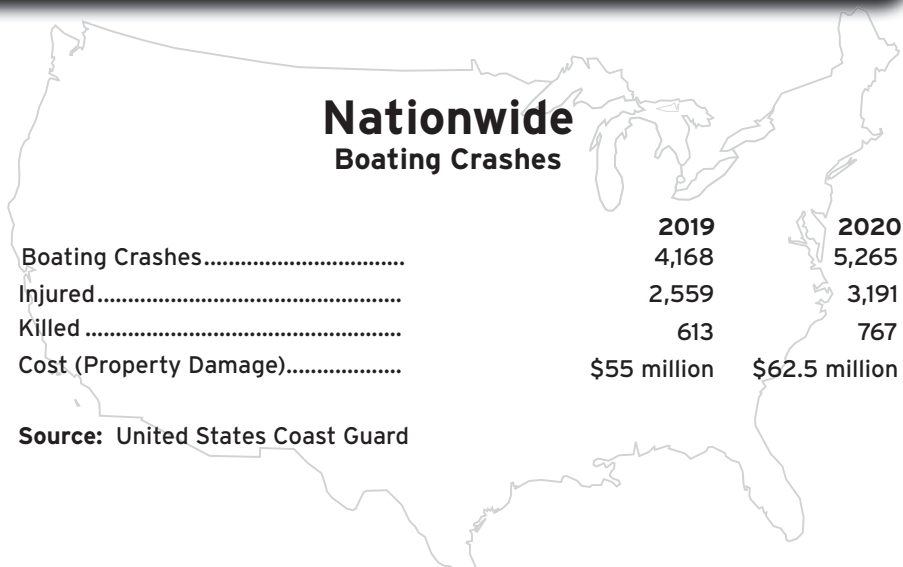

# Alcohol Involvement

**Drinking and Crashes** - Whether or not a person has been drinking cannot always be determined at the scene of a crash. Because of the time lapse from the moment of occurrence until an officer arrives at the scene to make the investigation, a person's condition concerning drinking can change a great deal. In cases where the individual may have been removed to a hospital, doctor's office or funeral home, his/her condition may never be determined.

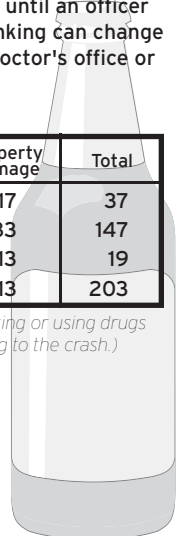

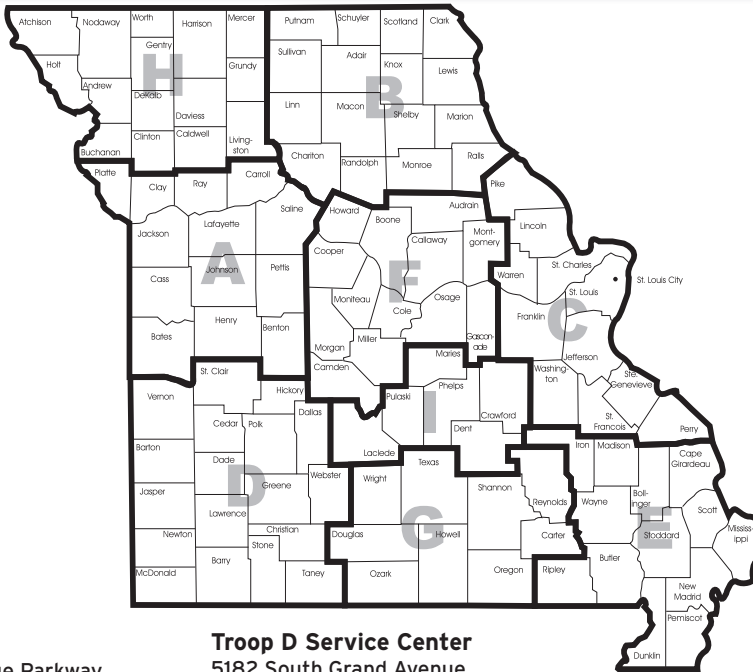
